Welcome to 2008, the Centenary Year of Rugby League. Last year the Club won a record equalling 7 Premierships, no doubt a great achievement. But somewhere along the way we seem to have lost the idea of what Junior Rugby League is all about.

Reading our Constitution, Part 2 relates to the objectives of the Club. These include:

"To promote, foster and encourage the game of Rugby League....."

"To organize training sessions to improve the Rugby League skills of the participants.."

This Club was formed to allow as many kids in the area as possible to play and enjoy Rugby League, and that objective has not changed. Whilst sometimes this means teams will play short or have more kids than needed, this will not affect the kids enjoyment of the game. Sure it might reduce the chances of the team winning, but that is neither an objective of this Club, nor a factor in why the kids play this game in the first place.

Rugby League, like any team sport, is about mateship and enjoyment. Success as a junior Club comes from creating friendships, improving team spirit and skills, not collecting Premiership jackets and these are the things parents should be looking for. Less than 0.1% of players will ever play at the elite level where it becomes all about winning, and most of those other 99.9% will not give a damn.

Personally, I played Rugby League for 12 years, mostly in the B team, and never played in a Grand Final. None of that diminished my enjoyment of the game and I made friends that I still have 20 years later....and I still miss playing.

Going into the 2008 season, the Centenary of Rugby League, let's remember what it is all about – enjoyment for the kids themselves. This Club is fortunate in having a hard working, strong Committee... please try to support them. By all means if you have concerns or ideas, bring them along to the meetings. Better yet, get involved yourself and help the Club meet it's true objectives.
